
Project Go to Bro



What is happening?

- We are moving from Go4schools to Bromcom.

What do I need to do? In advance...


- Before 24th February, make sure that you:
 - Download a copy of any reports that you want to keep.
 - Are on top of your homework tasks.
 - Can get onto your school email account from home.

What do I need to do? On the day...

- Activate your Bromcom account:
 - You will receive an invitation email and some instructions at around 8am on 24th
 February. The link will only work for 24 hours.
 - You can do this on a computer, tablet or phone.
 - Your username will be the same as on the school network.
 - If you have any issues getting on to Bromcom, please seek support, either in person or by emailing bromcom@northgate.suffolk.sch.uk.
- This is your mock exam week.
 - Other year groups will be starting at 9.30am on Monday 24th February *please ignore this...*
 - If you have an exam that morning, you need to be there for 8.45am.

What will I see?

- Once you are into Bromcom, you will see your dashboard.
- You can personalise your dashboard by:
 - changing the colours;
 - moving the sections around to suit you;
 - adding bookmarks to websites that you use regularly for school e.g. Sparx, GCSEpod etc.
